Sub: Information regarding Open National Selection trial for the South Asian Ju-Jitsu Championship -2026 at Sri Lanka.

Respected Sir / Madam,

This is to inform you that Ju-Jitsu Association of India is going to hold an Open national selection trial for Male & Female U – 16, U-18, Adults for the South Asian Ju-Jitsu Championship -2026 going to be held at Sri Lanka from 10th to 12th April 2026, under the auspicious the Ju-Jitsu Asian Union – JJAU, recognized by the Olympic Council of Asia.

The selection trials shall take place on **22nd March 2026, Sunday** at G.D. Goenka Public School, Rajnagar Extension, Ghaziabad, U.P. The competent / eligible athletes from different states / units can take part in the open trial. The athletes will be selected for the Championship in each weight / age category of Ju-Jitsu events i.e. Ne-Waza, Fighting Ju-Jitsu, Duo / Show.

Important:

- * The trials shall be for U – 16, U-18, Adults Male & Female only.
- * Athletes born in 2014 & below are eligible for trials.
- * Everyone has to bring & submit the copy of DOB Certificate, Adhaar Card, Valid Passport, Athlete's health declaration (Medical fitness Certificate), Waiver of Liability form.
- * Time to start the selection trials shall be 10.00 A.M. & onwards.
- * Accreditation & Weigh-in shall be done before the trials.
- * No TA/DA, No Accommodation shall be given.
- * The trials will be conducted on the basis of JAI/JJAU/JJIF Rules and Regulations.
- * The selection criteria are mentioned separately on the website of the association.
- * The athletes must be of the same state for which they have been entered for the selection trials.
- * National certified referees will conduct the event.
- * Proper Ju-Jitsu Gi and Ju-Jitsu equipment's are only allowed.
- * Each state association / parents etc must assume all responsibilities for any type of losses, accident and health insurance as well as civil liability for their participant & official.
- * The Ju-Jitsu Association of India, shall not be responsible of any claim of illness, injury, accidents, disabilities, losses, casualty, death of any participants / officials or medical emergencies what so ever during the trials. All participants will compete at their own risk. In the case of minors, parents/guardians are fully responsible for the participation of their wards. A declaration by parents /guardians should be produced during Documentation.
- * If any other situation arises that is not covered by this policy, it will be resolved by the majority decision of the selection Committee.

The details are mentioned for your information and necessary action. All are requested to forward the details of the participants on or before 20th of March 2026 to the e-mail id office@ju-jitsu.in to make the arrangements proper. Entries received through state association will only be accepted.
