SELECTION CRITERIA / POLICY OF THE JU-JITSU ASSOCIATION OF INDIA FOR THE SOUTH ASIAN JU-JITSU CHAMPIONSHIP – 2026, SRI LANKA

The Presidency & the Executive Board of the Ju-Jitsu Association of India – JAI has decided the selection criteria / policy for the athlete's participating in the upcoming South Asian Ju-Jitsu Championships – 2026, Sri Lanka. This selection criteria / policy shall be valid only for the upcoming South Asian Ju-Jitsu Championships – 2026, Sri Lanka for U-16, U- 18 & Adults, male / female.

1] As per the decision after the due discussion on the suggestions received from senior athletes, officials and state representatives, the following will be the only and valid selection criteria for selecting athletes / participants for the upcoming South Asian Ju-Jitsu Championship, Sri Lanka.

2] The clear base of the selection in the Indian Ju-Jitsu team for the South Asian Ju-Jitsu Championship, Sri Lanka shall be through the **Open National Selection trials**.

3] For the upcoming South Asian Ju-Jitsu Championship, Sri Lanka, only below mentioned athletes are eligible to take part in the **Open National Selection trials** –

1. Who *won medals or* participated in the U-21 & Adults National Championships – 2025 held at Saharanpur, U.P.
2. Who *won medals or* participated in the U- 14 /U-16 /U- 18 National Championships – 2025 at Haldwani, Uttarakhand.
3. Who *won medals or* participated in the Youth Asian Ju-Jitsu Championships – 2025, Thailand.
4. Who *won medals or* participated in the Asian Ju-Jitsu Championships (U-21 & Adults) – 2025 at Jordan.
5. Who *won medals or* participated in the Youth Ju-Jitsu World Championships – 2025, Thailand.
6. Who *won medals or* participated in the Adults Ju-Jitsu World Championships – 2025, Thailand.

** Those who won medals or participated in the 2025 Nationals [Year of Birth – 2012 / 2013 / 2014] are eligible to take part in the trials.*

The selection will be determined on the individual performance of each athlete, evaluated and finalized by the Selection committee.

4] The eligibility criteria to take part in the Open selection trials is clearly a medal winning performance in event / age / weight category or the participation in the event / age / weight category in the above-mentioned championship.

5] The participating / selected athletes must have a valid Passport minimum till 30th September 2026. The athletes must be Physically fit before the trials / championship.

6] In case if there are less or no athletes in any weight/age/event category during the trials, the selection of athlete's will be made final by the decision of the selection committee, The selection committee has all the rights to select athletes as per their previous performance and as per the medal winning probability. The selection committee can give a chance to the athletes who are able to participate and willing to join the event [athlete should be the part of the above-mentioned events.

7] The decision of the selection committee will be final.

** Participation in this event will be self-financed or self-sponsored by an individual, this event will not be funded or covered by the Ministry of Sports, Government of India. Therefore, the complete participation cost is to be borne by the individual participants themselves and/or by their sponsors etc.*

**The dates and venue for the selection trials of the Indian Ju-Jitsu Team for the Upcoming South Asian Ju-Jitsu Championship will be announced separately.*
